

Bolton Abbey filming guidelines

Throughout the year visitors take priority at all times.

We require at least two weeks notification prior to any filming or photography occurring on Estate land.

We will usually not close any part of the main Estate open to visitors to accommodate filming or photographic requests.

We can make no guarantee to minimise disturbance from passers by and would not expect the routine running of the Estate to be disrupted.

A contact must be signed prior to any filming in accordance with our insurance and our health and safety requirements.

The Estate must be indemnified against any claim that may arise from injury or damage to persons, property, or any third party as a result of your activities on Estate land.

We request a copy of public liability insurance and risk assessments prior to film to demonstrate that all risks arising have been identified, assessed, recorded and mitigated.

A location fee will be charged. We also make a charge to cover any staffing or additional cost incurred.
