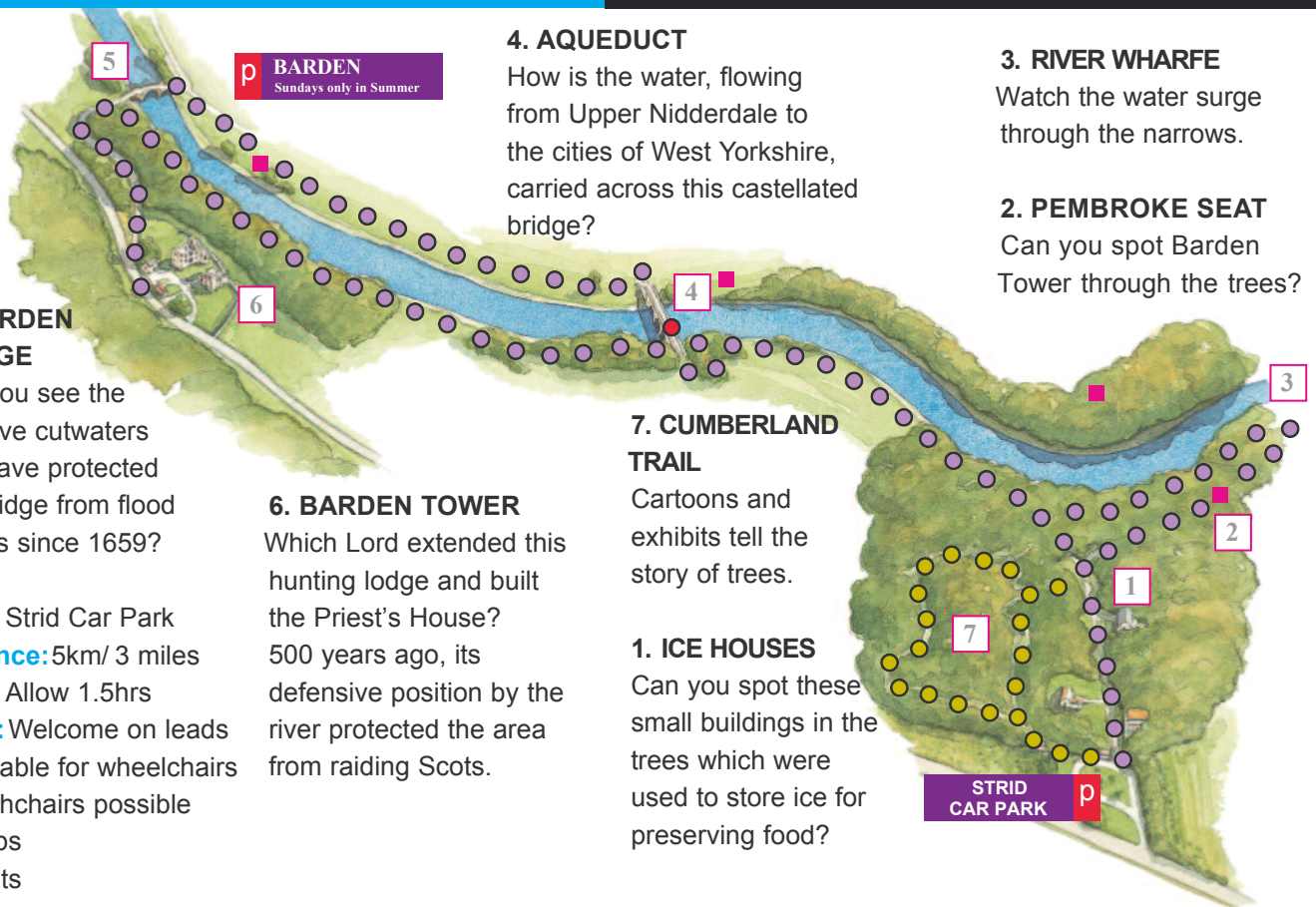


WINTER
